BACnet Airport Conference is trend-setting for digital transformation in building automation

Dortmund, August 30th, 2018. – „BACnet is a great solution for the application to airport facilities management and operation“, says H. Michael Newman, the founder of manufacturer-independent standardization in building automation. 10 participating airports will demonstrate this at the 1st BACnet Airport Conference on September 27–28, 2018 at Frankfurt Airport. A comprehensive presentation and lecture program exposes the digital transformation of building automation and is trend-setting for all types of buildings.

Newman is a pilot himself and he knows the needs of airport operators: “BACnet is extremely well situated for solving the airport manager’s problems.” He states: “Our standardized communication protocol contributes to reliable operation of systems, to security, sustainability and even to staff and passengers comfort.”

There is also an exchange of information with the BACnet-responsible ASHRAE committee "SSPC 135" and the American BACnet community.
